About the class:

Introductory to advanced level instruction in the printmaking medium of Monotype. Class size is limited to only seven artists to ensure one-onone time with instructor for development of learned skills and

imagery. Various techniques will be explored; including traditional monotype processes, additive and subtractive, viscosity, ghost image printing and more using non-toxic printing inks. This class is ideal for someone wishing to explore the medium of monotype printmaking in a breathtaking and temperate landscape.

Staniel Cay is the perfect island setting to be inspired and create. The naturally contrasting colors of the dark coral shoreline and aqua waters partnered with the laid back culture of the islands will culminate in a portfolio of prints and a group show at the Staniel Cay Yacht Club. Our studio will be at a long time resident / local artist's private, open-air, waterfront residence. We're pleased to offer this class with decades of travel and printmaking experience; this is truly a unique opportunity to print in the Bahamas.

About the instructor:

Lori Warner is considered a master printer in monotype. She specializes in unique woven monotype prints and encaustic paintings. Her work is luminous due to many layers of paper, ink and wax which often reveal forms referencing a specific person or landscape. Ms. Warner is a graduate of Rhode Island School of Design where she received highest honors

and the award for Excellence in Printmaking. She is the owner of Lori Warner Studio / Gallery in Chester, CT. Awards include, Best of Show, Boston Historical Parks Annual Exhibition, Second Place, 66th Annual Connecticut Artists Exhibition at the Slater Museum. Solo exhibitions include Soprafina Gallery, Boston, Chester Gallery and Westport Arts Center, Connecticut, and internationally juried group exhibitions in Hawaii, Michigan, New York and New Jersey. Staniel Cay is truly like no other place on earth. The island is nestled in the magnificent chain of Bahamian Out Islands called The Exuma Cays (a.k.a. "Exumas") and lies approximately 75 miles southeast of Nassau and

250 miles southeast of Florida. The island itself is less than two square miles in area and with a population of less than eighty full-time residents, Staniel Cay is the ideal place to escape from the cares of the world. PRINTMAKING WORKSHOP IN THE BAHAMAS!

Dates: Sat, April 20th - Sat, April 27th, 2013

Workshop Schedule: *

Mon-Fri: lunch to be delivered to studio at approx 12pm. Half-day boat excursion (time /weather permitting) with snorkel/

swim/sketch and picnic lunch at start of week.

Saturday, April 20th: Departure, 1pm Watermakers Air / Ft Lauderdale Executive Airport FXE (schedule your arrival to FLL - Ft Lauderdale before 11:30am for same day limo transfer to FXE - Watermakers Air flight). Check-in and welcome dinner at Yacht Club. Introduction, Workshop Booklet.

Sunday, April 21st: Get your bearings day! Explore the island, do some sketching, visit the studio, unpack. This is the day to settle in and acquaint yourself with Staniel Cay. Optional (and time/weather permitting) half day boat trip to see this unique island landscape and magnificent colors.

Monday, April 22nd: Workshop Overview and Introduction to Monotype process, brief history, set-up, supplies. Full-day demos in paper tearing, color mixing, additives using Akua Inks, painting directly onto plastic plates, press set-up and printing. Ongoing student exploration in mark making for monotype using additive and subtractive techniques with brayers, brushes, other tools.

Tuesday, April 23rd: Demo: viscosity rolls/ghost printing. Continuation of mark-making. Student exploration of learned techniques. Development of personal imagery.

Wednesday, April 24th: Optional demo: found objects, stencils. Discussion on printing in series; Typwtto clavelopxt and nurture an idea into a cohesive series. Optional: 4pm group critique.

Thursday, April 25th: All day supervised open printing, finish loose ends! Demo: curating, signing and packing artwork. Optional: 4pm group critique.

Friday, April 26th: Select, sign, package your artwork and clean up studio by 1pm. Deliver prints in portfolio either to SCYC or Lori by 3pm for hanging of art show. 5-7pm: Opening reception of workshop prints at Staniel Cay Yacht Club.

Saturday, April 27th (or stay longer without instruction): Departure 9:30am Staniel Cay (11:30 arrival at FXE - Ft Lauderdale, customs and car service to FLL - Ft Laud. If

departing Ft Laud, you MUST schedule your departure flight from FLL/Ft Lauderdale after 3:00pm).

* subject to change. SCYC retains right to use monotype artwork and workshop images for marketing/promotional purposes.

Due to small class size / limited availability, 50% of total workshop cost is due at time of booking, this includes a \$500 non-refundable deposit. Remaining balance due one week prior to departure (contact SCYC for exemptions).

- Flight: To/From Staniel Cay. (roundtrip ticket via Watermakers Air from FXE Ft Lauderdale Executive Airport and Staniel Cay, Exumas, Bahamas. (35lb luggage limit / per person, \$1.50/lb over limit charge, subject to space availability).

Notes should to be taken and referred to in addition to your workshop booklet, which will be handed out upon arrival in the Bahamas.
